7	Cornish Champion Static. Competitors must be a member of CBC. Any article, interior or exterior, functional or sculptural, produced using any technique in the competitor's workshop.	Free
Half Table	For Cornish businesses only – An opportunity to display your work to advertise your business.	£10
Demonstrate	For non-competing blacksmiths – in order to earn your free ticket to the show ground each day, Blacksmiths must demonstrate for half an hour per day.	FREE


