**Location:** If for any reason it is going to prove hard to get the trailer into your school, playground or playing field please get in contact with us as we can bring the roadshow to you using our truck. We have successfully set up in school halls for these visits and this allows us to work with a larger number of children

**Number of classes:** We are able to accommodate up to 20 EYFS & KS1 pupils and up to 15 KS2 pupils, in a 45minute session. The smaller the size of the group the better the experience.

**Curriculum:** This 'Roadshow' will travel the whole of Cornwall teaching young children about the importance of agriculture and also looking at healthy foods. The workshops have been developed to meet with the National Curriculum and aim to deliver a broad range of subjects, from Science to Geography, Design & Technology to History. The activities will be hands on and fun, suiting lots of different learning styles. We will have a volunteer with us on the day who will all have an agricultural background, from farming to land management the list is endless.

**Teachers:** We would expect to have a member of your staff available on this day to accompany the children whether it's the class teacher or the teaching assistant. We will also give you a pre and post visit activity to carry out with the children, this will be to enthuse them and allow them to prepare any questions they should have before we arrive and a follow up activity to allowing you to continue with this after we have left. Both of these activities will be easy to follow and will marry up with what we will be doing on the day we are with you.

We also ask that after we visit you could fill out an evaluation form, enabling us to identify what has worked well and also what we can improve for next year, making our Roadshow the best it can be.
