

## RCS Bees and Honey Entry Form 2017

1. Except where otherwise stated, the entry fee is £1 per class for the first five (5) classes and free for all subsequent entries.
2. Up to three (3) entries may be made in each class, but (Rule 6) only the best of them will be judged with the rest of the class, thereby restricting each competitor to one prize per class.

The Entry Form must be accompanied by the relevant fee, and should be sent to the Show Secretary, Kate Bowyer, The Nook, Lower Carnkie, Redruth, Cornwall, TR16 6SP to arrive before the 1<sup>st</sup> May 2017. Late entries will be accepted up to midday on the Wednesday before the show, but they will not be in the catalogue. No entries will be accepted on the morning of the show.
